

SHAC Minutes

1-22-14

Meeting was called to order by Dr. Thompson at 4:02 pm.

Minutes from 11-6-13 were reviewed. Loure Dews motioned to accept the minutes as presented. Derek Cook seconded the motion. Minutes were approved by voice vote.

Dr. Thompson, Mr. Miksch, and Lori Gaubatz provided an overview of HB 5 changes related to graduation requirements, testing, and course selection. It was noted that SISD is expected to continue to require ½ credit of Health as a graduation requirement even though it is not required by the state.

Kathy Wolford, SISD Food Service Director, provided an update on cafeteria menu choices. Based on service delivery counts, certain “unpopular” menu items have been discontinued and replaced with more popular choices that meet nutrition guidelines. Menu changes are communicated via the SISD website as well as announced at the campus level.

Updates on Scott & White Sexual Health and Wellness program and the p.a.p.a. program were shared by Dr. Thompson. Three teachers attended training via webcam as provided by Scott and White. They will begin providing the human sexuality instruction in the near future. At SJH, they will be teaching it through the PE classes to the 6th grade students. Becky Wojcik, school nurse, attended p.a.p.a. training in Waco and indicated that it was a very beneficial training. Arrangements will be made for her to train the HS health teachers to become p.a.p.a. trainers.

The SISD Wellness Policy and Action Plan was reviewed and evaluated. SHAC members made comments, corrections, and additions to the plan.

In Open Forum, Mr. Miksch pointed out the new promotional items which the District has purchased to be used in recruiting and promoting the District. Additionally, he shared about the possible upcoming bond election and the facility improvements that would likely be funded by the bonds, if approved.

It was noted that the next scheduled meeting is March 26, 2014, at 4:00 pm.
